The new internationally respected PKAYE / WTE Custodial Security Specification '03' a 'Specification for Custodial Inspection Hatches' has been drawn from the requirements of potential users and from the relevant parts of other hardware standards.

Designed and manufactured in Leeds, England it uses a lightweight alloy construction which is simple to operate. The slide mechanism will lock automatically and all edges are shaped to resist the attachment of any ligature.

The Kaye Custodial Inspection Hatch is tested to the new standard and is proven to withstand a static dead-load on any part of its inner surface without failure. It has long lasting operational durability and is resistant to wilful damage.
